Comprehension Skill: Sequence of events—tell the order in which things happen

Comprehension Strategy: Monitor/ clarify—find ways to figure out what doesn't make sense

Writing Focus: Narrative writingsentences

Activities to Do Together

Vocabulary

Ask your child to create gestures for this week's Words to Know. Write each word on a piece of paper. When you hold up a word, have your child use the gesture to act it out.

Who's Who at School

Ask your child to tell you about some of the people at school. Together make up a story in which one or more of those people are the main characters.

School Directory

Review the people your child has met at school. Ask your child to write a directory that names each person and tells about his or her job (being a student counts as a job, too!).
