Comprehension Strategy: Question—ask questions about what you are reading

Writing Focus: Narrative writing—sentences about yourself (main idea)

Activities to Do Together

Vocabulary

Ask your child to use this week's **Words to Know** as he or she acts out being an astronaut who is headed to the moon.

Headed for the Stars

If you could travel any place in outer space, where would you go? Together, talk about answers to this question, and what you might find when you got to your destination.

My Adventure
