Words to Know: door, more, mother, old, try, use, want, wash

Phonics Skills: Compound words; short vowel /e/ea as in *bear*

Vocabulary Strategy: Compound words

Comprehension Skill: Cause and effect—tell what happens and why

Comprehension Strategy: Infer/predict—use clues to figure out more about story parts

Writing Focus: Narrative writing—personal narrative

Vocabulary

Pretend you are one of the animals from **Silly Poems** or **Little Rabbit's Tale**. Have your child use this week's **Words to Know** to have a conversation with you.

Knock, Knock

Talk about some of the friends you invite to your home. What do you do to get ready for them? What happens after they arrive?
