Comprehension Strategy:

Summarize—stop to tell important events as you read

Writing Focus: Narrative writing—story

Activities to Do Together

Vocabulary

Play a guessing game together. Say some clues about one of this week's **Words to Know** and ask your child to guess the answer. For example, "We go to the store to do this." (buy)

Change Your Life

Talk about a time when you had a big change in your life, such as moving to a new home or changing jobs. Who helped make the change easier? Together, discuss the people you would rely on if you had to make a big change.

Come On In

Ask your child to imagine that a new family moved in next door. Have your child write a paragraph to describe how he or she would help the new neighbors feel welcome.
